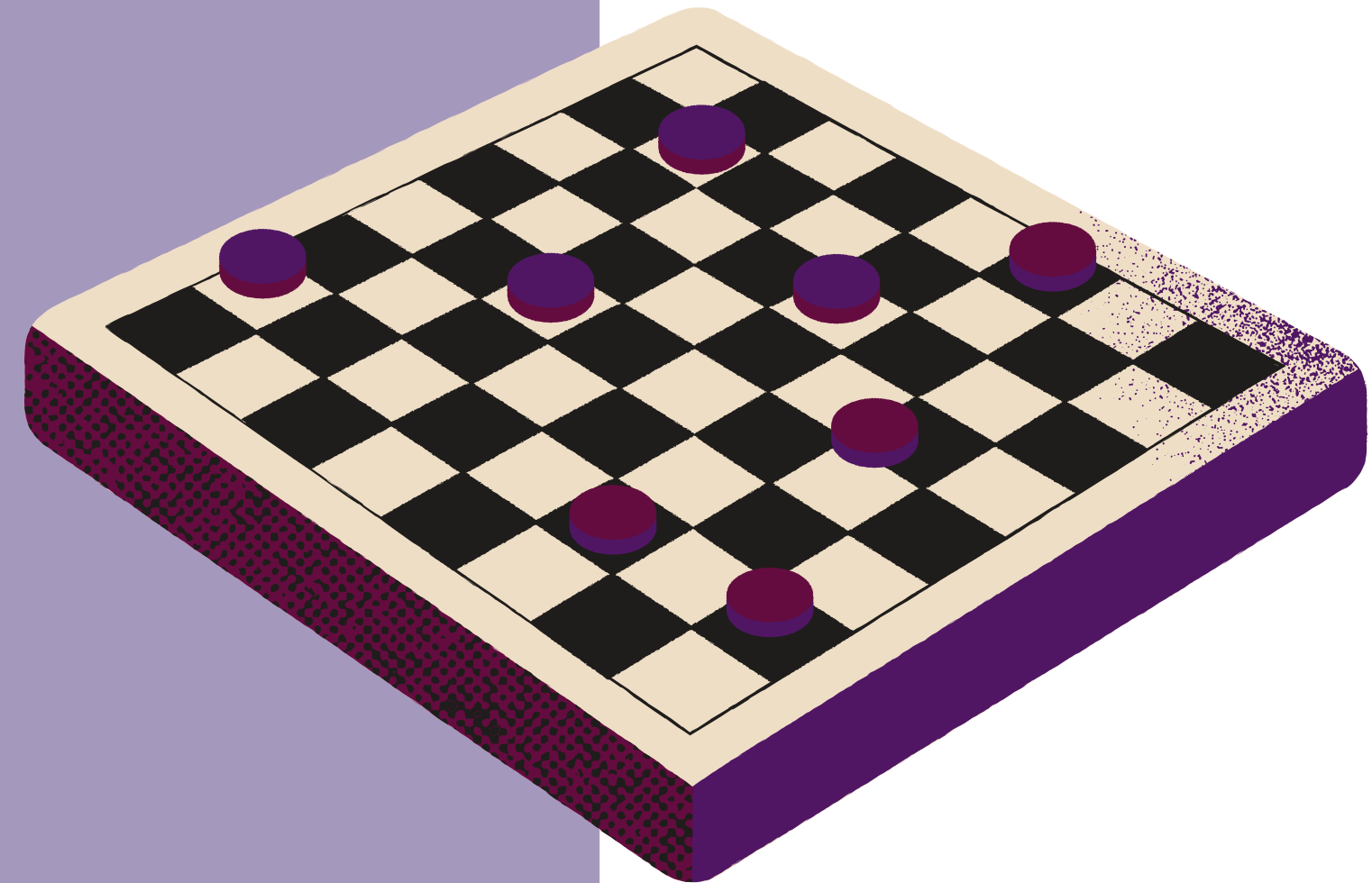

- Children are confronted with a lot of hate speech in the internet



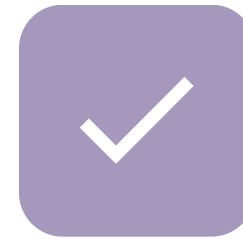
Forms of discrimination:

Forms of hate speech



Hate speech which is considered free speech in most countries



Threatening the life or physical health of a person, illegal



Spreading conspiracy ideology, e.g. in the context of antisemitism



Victim blaming, e.g. in the context of sexism

Examples

- help children figure out what goes beyond the norm and cannot be funny
- give children the opportunity to express in words how they see and comprehend the events, or simply give vent to their experiences
- guard against triggers by using more popular memes that have been in the public eye and more gentle comments
